so really happy to participate in this initiative. 41 00:03:13,677 --> 00:03:16,147 >> Thank you, thank you, thank you very much, 42 00:03:16,147 --> 00:03:18,560 sounds that we've got a lot of experience. 43 00:03:18,560 --> 00:03:23,025 I mean working with different organizations, specifically more 44 00:03:23,025 --> 00:03:27,657 recently with Cash learning partnership with a number of projects. 45 00:03:27,657 --> 00:03:33,563 I'm going on Cash and voucher assistance programs, MS Valerie, 46 00:03:33,563 --> 00:03:39,052 maybe you have like, you can introduce yourselves, I mean. 47 00:03:39,052 --> 00:03:43,464 >> Yes, hello everybody and glad to be with you today, 48 00:03:43,464 --> 00:03:49,597 to talk about the environmental impact of cash and voucher assistance. 49 00:03:49,597 --> 00:03:55,662 So I'm a researcher at the group allay, which is a nonprofit but 50 00:03:55,662 --> 00:04:00,957 I think Hank and humanitarian practices and policies. 51 00:04:00,957 --> 00:04:06,223 And I have been also filled a humanitarian worker for 52 00:04:06,223 --> 00:04:10,772 10 years, mainly with ICIC on the field and 53 00:04:10,772 --> 00:04:14,244 today as a researcher evaluator,

54 00:04:14,244 --> 00:04:19,272 I'm focusing on issues related to resilience and 55 00:04:19,272 --> 00:04:23,723 strategic programming of organizations. 56 00:04:23,723 --> 00:04:27,533 >> Okay, thank you very much for the introduction and 57 00:04:27,533 --> 00:04:31,875 hopefully today we'll have a very fruitful session, for 58 00:04:31,875 --> 00:04:36,482 I mean the audience maybe who are not familiar with the cash and 59 00:04:36,482 --> 00:04:41,623 voucher assistance, it's like slightly different with the social 60 00:04:41,623 --> 00:04:46,878 Safety net program, which is like kind of covered by the Government. 61 00:04:46,878 --> 00:04:52,101 However, always cash and vouches aimed to be like kind of integrated at the end 62 00:04:52,101 --> 00:04:57,105 during the recovery and development with the Social Safety net programs. 63 00:04:57,105 --> 00:05:02,251 But Cash and voucher if I like have to, given definitions using 64 00:05:02,251 --> 00:05:07,787 the cash learning partnership Close three, it actually is defined 65 00:05:07,787 --> 00:05:13,340 as the provision of money which is cash or vouchers to individuals. 66 00:05:13,340 --> 00:05:18,567 Which can be used as emergency relief to address basic

67 00:05:18,567 --> 00:05:23,921 needs such as food, shelter, health, sanitation. 68 00:05:23,921 --> 00:05:29,116 And also we can be like kind of as a mode of support to economic activities 69 00:05:29,116 --> 00:05:34,572 to like kind of those businesses were like disrupted during the crisis such 70 00:05:34,572 --> 00:05:40,114 as this recent like pandemic, it can help to build the economic the market, 71 00:05:40,114 --> 00:05:44,219 the local suppliers to get back to normal and business. 72 00:05:44,219 --> 00:05:49,101 So traditionally, I mean in kind assistance more 73 00:05:49,101 --> 00:05:53,295 like well like routine during disasters. 74 00:05:53,295 --> 00:05:59,246 So humanitarian organizations brought massive workloads of the goods and 75 00:05:59,246 --> 00:06:01,804 items delivered to the people. 76 00:06:01,804 --> 00:06:06,881 However more recently cash during the like Grand Bar game there 77 00:06:06,881 --> 00:06:13,011 was like an emphasis toward cash and voucher assistance instead of in kind, 78 00:06:13,011 --> 00:06:17,066 how are these two, are like very complimentary.

79 00:06:17,066 --> 00:06:22,145 And so we see a dramatic growth for cash and 80 00:06:22,145 --> 00:06:28,545 voucher from 2016, 2019 which is double. 81 00:06:28,545 --> 00:06:33,020 So today is like around 18% of humanitarian assistance 82 00:06:33,020 --> 00:06:37,506 allocated in terms of I mean cash and voucher assistance. 83 00:06:37,506 --> 00:06:40,153 So that's the importance of this phenomenon. 84 00:06:40,153 --> 00:06:45,641 And looking into these cash and voucher assistance programming, 85 00:06:45,641 --> 00:06:49,075 there are lots of guidelines to all kids. 86 00:06:49,075 --> 00:06:53,099 And reports from different humanitarian organization, 87 00:06:53,099 --> 00:06:57,942 they looked into different aspect of cash and voucher, for example, 88 00:06:57,942 --> 00:07:01,143 Cash and voucher and effectiveness, Cash and 89 00:07:01,143 --> 00:07:05,926 voucher and data responsibility, Cash and voucher preparedness. 90 00:07:05,926 --> 00:07:11,057 However, looking into the literature that like few studies conducted 91 00:07:11,057 --> 00:07:16,103 specifically by academics to connect and look into the environmental 92 00:07:16,103 --> 00:07:21,076

aspect of cash and voucher assistance, which is slightly missing. 93 00:07:21,076 --> 00:07:25,264 There are a couple of reports more recently published 94 00:07:25,264 --> 00:07:27,877 which is one is published by URD. 95 00:07:27,877 --> 00:07:32,901 And Valerie is one of the co author of this report, which they regularly look 96 00:07:32,901 --> 00:07:38,096 into the environmental impact using a couple of case studies based in Africa. 97 00:07:38,096 --> 00:07:44,006 So I'm gonna question Valerie, so can you just say that whether 98 00:07:44,006 --> 00:07:50,470 it is like this concept linking environment to the cash is important? 99 00:07:50,470 --> 00:07:55,453 And so what you found from those your research which is 100 00:07:55,453 --> 00:08:01,220 published in that report, maybe you can briefly summarize? 101 00:08:01,220 --> 00:08:04,175 >> [COUGH] Thank you Hammond. 102 00:08:04,175 --> 00:08:08,504 It is true that today, given the perspective of 103 00:08:08,504 --> 00:08:12,727 systemic humanitarian crisis in the future, 104 00:08:12,727 --> 00:08:18,142 humanitarian actors are becoming increasingly more aware

00:08:18,142 --> 00:08:23,465 of the repercussions of their action on the environment. 106 00:08:23,465 --> 00:08:28,174 This includes their environmental footprint, 107 00:08:28,174 --> 00:08:33,568 footprint of their operations and this is true for CVA, 108 00:08:33,568 --> 00:08:40,568 cash and voter assistance, but it is not limited only to the footprint, 109 00:08:40,568 --> 00:08:46,336 environmental impact must be analyzed in a broader sense. 110 00:08:46,336 --> 00:08:48,871 And as you say, it until now, 111 00:08:48,871 --> 00:08:54,351 this issue has been overlooked by humanitarian organization, 112 00:08:54,351 --> 00:08:59,838 in this imperative to save lives in complex emergency context. 113 00:08:59,838 --> 00:09:04,473 And it is true that the criteria of efficiency and 114 00:09:04,473 --> 00:09:08,881 choice of beneficiaries have often been given 115 00:09:08,881 --> 00:09:13,076 priority over environmental protection. 116 00:09:13,076 --> 00:09:16,958 >> Thank you, so you say actually the key challenge, 117 00:09:16,958 --> 00:09:20,298 I mean cash and voucher is very important and 118 00:09:20,298 --> 00:09:24,827

then look into the environmental impact of it is critical. 119 00:09:24,827 --> 00:09:30,150 However, you mentioned that like it's I mean, the priority is given to the like 120 00:09:30,150 --> 00:09:35,728 kind of purchasing power, dignity and also the cost effectiveness of the program. 121 00:09:35,728 --> 00:09:40,880 So, maybe Jose you want to add anything else, I mean, 122 00:09:40,880 --> 00:09:45,920 on this relationship and then why it's like kind of, 123 00:09:45,920 --> 00:09:50,400 I mean ignored by humanitarian practitioner, 124 00:09:50,400 --> 00:09:54,555 is it not their priority at the first place? 125 00:09:54,555 --> 00:09:59,030 >> Yeah, thank you, I mean, I just would like to add that, 126 00:09:59,030 --> 00:10:03,228 I mean, we need first probably to understand cash and 127 00:10:03,228 --> 00:10:07,078 bolted assistance evolution in the past years. 128 00:10:07,078 --> 00:10:12,880 And we can say that in reality CVA started as a system changer and 129 00:10:12,880 --> 00:10:17,700 a severe practitioners, we needed to fight against 130 00:10:17,700 --> 00:10:22,193 many preconceptions in regards to corruption, 131 00:10:22,193 --> 00:10:27,473

to misuse of money, political acceptance, etcetera. 132 00:10:27,473 --> 00:10:32,476 And every time we needed to justify very hard while we were 133 00:10:32,476 --> 00:10:37,283 using cash, instead of kind of or service provision. 134 00:10:37,283 --> 00:10:44,088 This as you playing it in the introduction has has changed in many respects and 135 00:10:44,088 --> 00:10:49,756 yeah the use of cash has double right from 2016 to 2019. 136 00:10:49,756 --> 00:10:54,937 And now the question is not anymore about the quantity, but more about the quality. 137 00:10:54,937 --> 00:10:59,124 And this aspect of quality includes of course the integration of 138 00:10:59,124 --> 00:11:03,623 environmental considerations, just very briefly in this regard, 139 00:11:03,623 --> 00:11:08,373 CVA is not very different to the other type of humanitarian assistance. 140 00:11:08,373 --> 00:11:13,366 But truth is that CVA has some characteristics that could 141 00:11:13,366 --> 00:11:18,775 support environmental footprint reduction and we believe or 142 00:11:18,775 --> 00:11:23,468 I believe that CBA stakeholders need to commit to it. 143 00:11:23,468 --> 00:11:26,833 CBA was not conceived to law our environmental footprint of

144

00:11:26,833 --> 00:11:28,519 the humanitarian response. 145 00:11:28,519 --> 00:11:33,731 But yes, to simplify processes, increase the rapid response and 146 00:11:33,731 --> 00:11:39,976 adapt better the response to beneficiary needs and local systems and context. 147 00:11:39,976 --> 00:11:44,592 So all of this should also live right to the decrease of 148 00:11:44,592 --> 00:11:47,986 the environmental footprint itself. 149 00:11:47,986 --> 00:11:54,489 >> Yeah, thank you, thank you for that, that's very important initiative, 150 00:11:54,489 --> 00:11:59,908 you mentioned that apart from that, one of the key challenges. 151 00:11:59,908 --> 00:12:05,286 I mean, Watery also mentioned the report, there was like kind of as you mentioned, 152 00:12:05,286 --> 00:12:10,617 that is giving priority to the other like kind of humanitarian plants principles. 153 00:12:10,617 --> 00:12:15,298 Which is very important, like giving the dignity and also is the speed of 154 00:12:15,298 --> 00:12:20,225 the delivering of it, which is mostly important, so like the priorities. 155 00:12:20,225 --> 00:12:25,825 And then apart from that you mentioned also, there's like lack of appropriate

156 00:12:25,825 --> 00:12:31,007 tools to actually h specifically standard tools to measure this kind of, 157 00:12:31,007 --> 00:12:36,376 to integrate the environmental impact indication about your assistance. 158 00:12:36,376 --> 00:12:40,861 We want to add or like kind of 159 00:12:40,861 --> 00:12:45,542 explain on this challenge. 160 00:12:45,542 --> 00:12:50,999 >> Yeah, maybe just to follow on this, it is true that a certain 161 00:12:50,999 --> 00:12:55,921 number of organizations recently have become more and 162 00:12:55,921 --> 00:13:02,452 increasingly aware of the end of their environmental responsibility. 163 00:13:02,452 --> 00:13:08,910 And that's why some organizations developed environmental policies and 164 00:13:08,910 --> 00:13:13,215 they are looking at the impact of their actions and 165 00:13:13,215 --> 00:13:18,973 actually it doesn't contradict some humanitarian principles. 166 00:13:18,973 --> 00:13:24,548 Because we can consider that it's a question of overall 167 00:13:24,548 --> 00:13:31,547 coherence of responsibility with regard to the do no harm principle, 168 00:13:31,547 --> 00:13:35,833 which is also a key humanitarian concept.

169 00:13:35,833 --> 00:13:41,394 However, as you say, the the environmental cost of aid operations, 170 00:13:41,394 --> 00:13:47,614 in terms of reducing their environmental footprint as well as other potential 171 00:13:47,614 --> 00:13:54,139 effects of CVA on the environment are rarely taken into accounting programming. 172 00:13:54,139 --> 00:13:59,421 And this is mainly also by the lack of tools and 173 00:13:59,421 --> 00:14:04,427 guides to assess the potential impacts and 174 00:14:04,427 --> 00:14:07,637 risks on the environment. 175 00:14:07,637 --> 00:14:09,526 >> Yeah, that's a good point. 176 00:14:09,526 --> 00:14:15,978 And adding to that, I found like there is sustainability and 177 00:14:15,978 --> 00:14:23,444 environmental standards which also populist in the sphere project, 178 00:14:23,444 --> 00:14:27,886 they are like more on in kind assistance. 179 00:14:27,886 --> 00:14:32,821 So, I wonder what it is like kind of any standard methods 180 00:14:32,821 --> 00:14:37,441 like to measure the environmental impact of cash and 181 00:14:37,441 --> 00:14:43,321 voucher assistance, which is not specified in a sphere project,

182 00:14:43,321 --> 00:14:48,781 but in other kind of guidelines or tool kits, if there is any. 183 00:14:48,781 --> 00:14:52,163 >> I believe if you take one of the criteria of the CHS, 184 00:14:52,163 --> 00:14:54,160 the core humanitarian standard. 185 00:14:54,160 --> 00:14:56,898 [INAUDIBLE] >> Yes. 186 00:14:56,898 --> 00:15:01,209 >> To avoid and mitigate the negative impacts of any 187 00:15:01,209 --> 00:15:06,587 humanitarian intervention, notably on the environment. 188 00:15:06,587 --> 00:15:12,436 But we can also think on the negative impact on the social conditions and 189 00:15:12,436 --> 00:15:17,314 some organizations argue that we shall combine the respect 190 00:15:17,314 --> 00:15:22,307 towards the environment and to minimum social conditions. 191 00:15:22,307 --> 00:15:24,975 Both must be linked and combined. 192 00:15:24,975 --> 00:15:27,172 >> 0kay. 193 00:15:27,172 --> 00:15:34,123 I may ask Jose, is there any other further challenges when we want to for example, 194 00:15:34,123 --> 00:15:40,977 integrate the environmental impact of environmental indicators to

the cash and 195 00:15:40,977 --> 00:15:45,313 voucher programs through a cash operation cycle, 196 00:15:45,313 --> 00:15:50,785 Is there any other challenges which inhibits the application? 197 00:15:50,785 --> 00:15:55,093 >> Yeah. 198 00:15:55,093 --> 00:15:59,911 Just to add on the former, It's true 199 00:15:59,911 --> 00:16:05,203 that CBA is flexible in terms of design. 200 00:16:05,203 --> 00:16:08,598 >> And in terms of how you design the program, and 201 00:16:08,598 --> 00:16:14,279 how you adapt it to the specific context and to the objectives of the program. 202 00:16:14,279 --> 00:16:19,088 >> So in this regard, is quite important to make sure that we 203 00:16:19,088 --> 00:16:24,003 are considering the environmental aspect at all levels, 204 00:16:24,003 --> 00:16:30,834 when we are in regards to the present cycles, to the specific CBA present cycle. 205 00:16:30,834 --> 00:16:36,486 When we are looking at purely operational impact of CBA, 206 00:16:36,486 --> 00:16:43,315 this is something that is considered already in a couple of studies, 207 00:16:43,315 --> 00:16:47,435

not the one already mentioned from URD and 208 00:16:47,435 --> 00:16:51,109 another one not from UMSCR and AROP. 209 00:16:51,109 --> 00:16:56,685 It is indeed a good begining but still there's the need not for 210 00:16:56,685 --> 00:17:01,406 more evidences especially when we are comparing CBA 211 00:17:01,406 --> 00:17:06,033 environmental footprint with other modalities. 212 00:17:06,033 --> 00:17:11,282 One indicator about the, one indicator that is showing 213 00:17:11,282 --> 00:17:16,421 that the awareness is increasing is that for example, 214 00:17:16,421 --> 00:17:23,248 they go in it's thematic policy on transfer paper that is still in Iraq. 215 00:17:23,248 --> 00:17:28,959 Is including here the need to make full use of the low environmental 216 00:17:28,959 --> 00:17:34,574 impact of cash and the benefits of supporting local production. 217 00:17:34,574 --> 00:17:39,532 And also mentioning that market assessment should include an environmental 218 00:17:39,532 --> 00:17:40,528 perspective. 219 00:17:40,528 --> 00:17:46,527 So all those are changes that will most probably 220 00:17:46,527 --> 00:17:51,928

have an impact in the futher consideration 221 00:17:51,928 --> 00:17:56,890 of those criteria in CBA programming. 222 00:17:56,890 --> 00:18:00,665 >> Okay, thank you very much. 223 00:18:00,665 --> 00:18:05,386 You've highlighted actually this connection of environmental 224 00:18:05,386 --> 00:18:10,115 indicators can be integrated through the cash operation cycle. 225 00:18:10,115 --> 00:18:16,844 This is a good approach to start looking into the cash operation cycle. 226 00:18:16,844 --> 00:18:22,271 Which is starting by the rigor needs assessment, and then market assessment, 227 00:18:22,271 --> 00:18:26,492 and then contracting with the financial service providers. 228 00:18:26,492 --> 00:18:30,584 Procurement of the FSPs or financial service provider and 229 00:18:30,584 --> 00:18:35,022 then the implementation design of CBA, and then monitoring. 230 00:18:35,022 --> 00:18:41,788 So if you want to for example add couple of practices to actually, 231 00:18:41,788 --> 00:18:50,166 to integrate these environmental practices through the cash operation cycle. 232 00:18:50,166 --> 00:18:54,781 Do you want to add any kind of practices based on your experience?

00:18:54,781 --> 00:18:59,589 Or you can give an example in a specific contribute they've done. 234 00:18:59,589 --> 00:19:04,548 For example, I've had UNHCR, they had a project 235 00:19:04,548 --> 00:19:09,980 based in what kind of eruption response in Colombia and 236 00:19:09,980 --> 00:19:15,649 then through the cash working group in Colombia together 237 00:19:15,649 --> 00:19:20,400 with UNDP they compiled a couple of practices. 238 00:19:20,400 --> 00:19:24,979 This is just published in 2020, and they for 239 00:19:24,979 --> 00:19:30,005 example, they mentioned about minimizing the paper 240 00:19:30,005 --> 00:19:34,708 voucher which is not environmentally friendly. 241 00:19:34,708 --> 00:19:39,239 However, the question is that in certain areas specifically in developing 242 00:19:39,239 --> 00:19:43,912 countries affected by disaster, maybe the infrastructure is not in place for 243 00:19:43,912 --> 00:19:46,491 example technological infrastructure. 244 00:19:46,491 --> 00:19:53,779 So how to cope with that, reducing the paper vouchers which you know from, 245 00:19:53,779 --> 00:19:57,837 Is there any trade off between these two?

272 00:21:54,501 --> 00:21:58,382 That is further informing the value of the grant. 273 00:21:58,382 --> 00:22:02,358 This was done for example for the minimum expenditure basket in Uganda. 274 00:22:02,358 --> 00:22:05,401 Integrating in the value of the grant, 275 00:22:05,401 --> 00:22:09,275 the needs that were relating to access to energy, 276 00:22:09,275 --> 00:22:14,623 ensuring that somehow they will be able to purchase those products or 277 00:22:14,623 --> 00:22:19,998 services at the market level and not to go into the nature and find it. 278 00:22:19,998 --> 00:22:21,030 >> Thank you. 279 00:22:21,030 --> 00:22:25,905 Jose, that's a very good example and case this in Africa. 280 00:22:25,905 --> 00:22:29,750 So you mean that this environmental concern or 281 00:22:29,750 --> 00:22:33,796 practices can be integrated to the for example, 282 00:22:33,796 --> 00:22:39,235 to the needs assessment and market assessment that they want to. 283 00:22:39,235 --> 00:22:44,174 For example, do the cash visibility and then they consider this with 284 00:22:44,174 --> 00:22:49,113 the suppliers and also with the people who are purchasing to make

sure

285 00:22:49,113 --> 00:22:54,071 that they're okay, they are environmentally friendly products. 286 00:22:54,071 --> 00:22:57,920 And then also on energy efficiency of for example, 287 00:22:57,920 --> 00:23:02,218 using renewable energies when they want to for example, 288 00:23:02,218 --> 00:23:06,978 the use or spend their cash for example, instead of firewood. 289 00:23:06,978 --> 00:23:10,461 Valerie, you want to add anything to this? 290 00:23:10,461 --> 00:23:17,552 >> Yeah, it's very interesting all these technical details and 291 00:23:17,552 --> 00:23:23,036 examples given by Jose and I fully agree of course 292 00:23:23,036 --> 00:23:28,119 that it is important to start and to improve, 293 00:23:28,119 --> 00:23:33,641 anticipating risk of this type of programming. 294 00:23:33,641 --> 00:23:41,922 And this must rely notably on existing tools like market analysis, 295 00:23:41,922 --> 00:23:45,844 analysis of energy supply, and 296 00:23:45,844 --> 00:23:53,414 also the types of use by the households of the energy sources. 297 00:23:53,414 --> 00:23:59,625 As well as an analysis of the local supplies of suppliers,

298 00:23:59,625 --> 00:24:04,566 to find ways to deliver cash or vouchers in a way 299 00:24:04,566 --> 00:24:09,539 which can be beneficial for the environment. 300 00:24:09,539 --> 00:24:17,657 And that's my second point beyond this direct operational impact of the CBA, 301 00:24:17,657 --> 00:24:21,961 there is a need also to think of the broader 302 00:24:21,961 --> 00:24:27,017 effects of the programming on the environment. 303 00:24:27,017 --> 00:24:33,263 What I mean is more related to the broader objective of the programme. 304 00:24:33,263 --> 00:24:36,463 Like any type of intervention, 305 00:24:36,463 --> 00:24:41,321 CBA must think in terms of global objective, and 306 00:24:41,321 --> 00:24:46,298 I believe that there are ways to better promote and 307 00:24:46,298 --> 00:24:50,446 to boost the positive potential of CBA for 308 00:24:50,446 --> 00:24:54,595 such objectives like the preservation or 309 00:24:54,595 --> 00:24:58,297 the protection of the environment. 310 00:24:58,297 --> 00:25:05,150 So for instance, one way to do this is to combine distribution of cash or

324 00:26:11,133 --> 00:26:14,030 Thank you Valerie. 325 00:26:14,030 --> 00:26:16,790 It's very good points. 326 00:26:16,790 --> 00:26:21,285 You refer to both, okay first at the strategic level, 327 00:26:21,285 --> 00:26:27,444 this environmental concept needs to be integrated to the whole concept and 328 00:26:27,444 --> 00:26:32,626 idea of humanitarian assistance and specifically for cash and 329 00:26:32,626 --> 00:26:37,440 voucher to combine and promote sustainable production. 330 00:26:37,440 --> 00:26:41,841 And also responsible consumption to just integrate in to the whole 331 00:26:41,841 --> 00:26:46,094 process of the cash operation cycle, which is very important. 332 00:26:46,094 --> 00:26:52,256 And also who they mentioned are more on operational level. 333 00:26:52,256 --> 00:26:57,471 On that, what kind of technical aspect can be approached 334 00:26:57,471 --> 00:27:02,687 across different phases and different stages of cash and 335 00:27:02,687 --> 00:27:08,680 voucher program cycle to develop more sustainable activities? 336 00:27:08,680 --> 00:27:14,393 This is absolutely connect to the sustainable development goals agenda,

337 00:27:14,393 --> 00:27:20,377 which is highly emphasized and the climate change and environmental issues. 338 00:27:20,377 --> 00:27:26,468 and also the use of cash which is highly important starting like grand bargain. 339 00:27:26,468 --> 00:27:29,481 So definitely it is to all relevant, and 340 00:27:29,481 --> 00:27:34,180 can be integrated definitely there are other priorities, but 341 00:27:34,180 --> 00:27:38,008 of course environmental issues can be respected. 342 00:27:38,008 --> 00:27:43,088 And apart from that and during the, operationally I found that it's 343 00:27:43,088 --> 00:27:48,871 on procurement of financial service provided because they play a huge role for 344 00:27:48,871 --> 00:27:52,835 cash transfers to the beneficiaries that last mile. 345 00:27:52,835 --> 00:27:59,723 And specifically with this era of digitalization. 346 00:27:59,723 --> 00:28:01,766 So it's improve the cash and 347 00:28:01,766 --> 00:28:07,220 voucher assistant effectiveness as it increase the speed of the delivery, 348 00:28:07,220 --> 00:28:12,844 and also reduce somehow the environmental impact because it's no printing,

349 00:28:12,844 --> 00:28:16,275 documentation, so it helps the environment. 350 00:28:16,275 --> 00:28:19,603 So for the procurement, do you have any suggestions? 351 00:28:19,603 --> 00:28:25,268 When humanitarian organizations, they connect with the FSPs, 352 00:28:25,268 --> 00:28:30,829 so when they let contract framework, any kind of practices they 353 00:28:30,829 --> 00:28:37,017 can include to the contract with regard to the environmental aspects? 354 00:28:37,017 --> 00:28:44,346 >> Well, one thing to highlight here is the fact that probably there is, 355 00:28:44,346 --> 00:28:50,818 obviously there is a big push for digitalization in general. 356 00:28:50,818 --> 00:28:54,901 And this is also at the core of the cash and 357 00:28:54,901 --> 00:28:58,517 voucher assistance programming. 358 00:28:58,517 --> 00:29:06,186 Still, this is something that needs to be probably a little better understood, 359 00:29:06,186 --> 00:29:10,811 especially when we are speaking about comparing 360 00:29:10,811 --> 00:29:15,346 the environmental footprint of the physical. 361 00:29:15,346 --> 00:29:19,952 Let's say, the well printing cards and

362 00:29:19,952 --> 00:29:25,926 the physical cards, et cetera versus the digital. 363 00:29:25,926 --> 00:29:30,261 Also, we see in regards to the needs of energy and so on, 364 00:29:30,261 --> 00:29:33,690 we need to better understand and quantify. 365 00:29:33,690 --> 00:29:40,443 Also know the environmental footprint of digital 366 00:29:40,443 --> 00:29:45,142 and digital transaction and etcetera. 367 00:29:45,142 --> 00:29:50,000 So, still this is one aspect where I believe that 368 00:29:50,000 --> 00:29:54,989 more research is needed in order to clarify that. 369 00:29:54,989 --> 00:29:58,018 But, And 370 00:29:58,018 --> 00:30:03,635 here we are trying also to prioritize needs and 371 00:30:03,635 --> 00:30:08,106 preferences of the aid recipients. 372 00:30:08,106 --> 00:30:14,320 And for that digitalization it's in many context. 373 00:30:14,320 --> 00:30:19,003 It's kind of the right way in order to reduce transportation costs. 374 00:30:19,003 --> 00:30:24,636 And transportation, also environmental footprint, etc.

415 00:33:36,424 --> 00:33:40,287 environmental preservation through 416 00:33:40,287 --> 00:33:45,607 the implementation of complementary approaches. 417 00:33:45,607 --> 00:33:51,027 Combining CVA with market based interventions. 418 00:33:51,027 --> 00:33:57,134 Technical assistance towards the suppliers, for instance, the providers. 419 00:33:57,134 --> 00:34:02,821 Or awareness raising activities in terms of environmental 420 00:34:02,821 --> 00:34:07,379 education, eco-friendly practices, etc. 421 00:34:07,379 --> 00:34:12,874 And again, as Jose said, I fully agree, to avoid also transferring 422 00:34:12,874 --> 00:34:19,435 the responsibility of the environmental footprint towards the beneficiaries. 423 00:34:19,435 --> 00:34:25,993 It's the responsibility of the operators to think and anticipate beforehand. 424 00:34:25,993 --> 00:34:32,398 And finally, my last point would be to maybe reinforce the coordination 425 00:34:32,398 --> 00:34:37,648 between the CVA community and the environment community. 426 00:34:37,648 --> 00:34:42,986 Or those practitioners, even in the aid sector,

And this also involve climate related shocks and 441 00:35:54,975 --> 00:35:58,395 natural disaster, environmental crisis. 442 00:35:58,395 --> 00:36:02,125 So this is something that in reality is already happening. 443 00:36:02,125 --> 00:36:06,369 And there are documented example, right, of effect of cash. 444 00:36:06,369 --> 00:36:10,137 Reducing, for example, deforestation in Indonesia. 445 00:36:10,137 --> 00:36:14,440 Or reducing negative coping strategies, like avoiding selling 446 00:36:14,440 --> 00:36:18,987 productive assets when people are affected by drought in Ethiopia. 447 00:36:18,987 --> 00:36:26,256 Or cash supporting health to prepare to monsoon big flutes hitting in Bangladesh. 448 00:36:26,256 --> 00:36:32,446 So, however, this capacity of CVA to address environmental shocks needs, 449 00:36:32,446 --> 00:36:36,461 as I said, not to better visibilize and explore. 450 00:36:36,461 --> 00:36:40,157 Gathering more evidences about it and 451 00:36:40,157 --> 00:36:45,360 also suggest programmatic adaptation when needed. 452 00:36:45,360 --> 00:36:51,045 Another thing is also to highlight that, well, 453 00:36:51,045 --> 00:36:56,036

in regards to the tools and how to integrate 454 00:36:56,036 --> 00:37:02,290 the environmental aspect in the CVA specific tools. 455 00:37:02,290 --> 00:37:07,497 I won't say we are speaking about developing specific tools for that or 456 00:37:07,497 --> 00:37:12,200 create, but more adapting or complementing the existing one. 457 00:37:12,200 --> 00:37:15,604 So we can contribute to the integration, right, 458 00:37:15,604 --> 00:37:21,211 of climate change environmental criteria at various levels of CVA programming. 459 00:37:21,211 --> 00:37:25,491 And finally, just to highlight that, I mean, CVA and 460 00:37:25,491 --> 00:37:28,384 environment is the future, right? 461 00:37:28,384 --> 00:37:32,743 And the interest is already here. 462 00:37:32,743 --> 00:37:37,553 And the proof also is this Nascent Community of Practice 463 00:37:37,553 --> 00:37:42,477 from December 2020 that now is being hosted by CaLP. 464 00:37:42,477 --> 00:37:45,622 But there are more than 50 organization and 465 00:37:45,622 --> 00:37:50,588 agencies that are participating and has showed they're interested in 466 00:37:50,588 --> 00:37:55,404

engaging further in this common space between CVA and environment. 467 00:37:55,404 --> 00:38:02,553 So this is somehow showing us the way to follow. 468 00:38:02,553 --> 00:38:03,957 >> Thank you, thank you, Jose. 469 00:38:03,957 --> 00:38:05,182 Good points you mentioned. 470 00:38:05,182 --> 00:38:08,710 And it's like your last point, I mean, CaLP, 471 00:38:08,710 --> 00:38:12,427 I'm sure that they're different initiatives. 472 00:38:12,427 --> 00:38:18,669 But cash and environment is one of the new initiatives since starting 2020. 473 00:38:18,669 --> 00:38:22,723 And it's very, I mean, excellent opportunity. 474 00:38:22,723 --> 00:38:27,163 As there are many different NGOs involving in such a network and 475 00:38:27,163 --> 00:38:28,936 community of practice. 476 00:38:28,936 --> 00:38:34,993 They share idea about this kind of how we can implement this environmental impact, 477 00:38:34,993 --> 00:38:37,338 education voucher assistant. 478 00:38:37,338 --> 00:38:40,675 How to measure it, how to integrate it with the programs. 479 00:38:40,675 --> 00:38:43,502

So I think more are upcoming and 480 00:38:43,502 --> 00:38:48,737 I'm sure that Super House we can get involved with this. 481 00:38:48,737 --> 00:38:52,970 We see more evidence based research and studies looking into 482 00:38:52,970 --> 00:38:58,037 the environmental effect of cash and voucher assistance in the future. 483 00:38:58,037 --> 00:39:03,583 And Valerie, you mentioned that it's like kind of the need to provide 484 00:39:03,583 --> 00:39:08,856 more awareness, public awareness on the environmental issues. 485 00:39:08,856 --> 00:39:14,216 Specifically on those countries affected by disasters and vulnerable people. 486 00:39:14,216 --> 00:39:20,184 But this need a systematic procedure and also advocacy with the government. 487 00:39:20,184 --> 00:39:25,432 And then different stakeholders to make this as 488 00:39:25,432 --> 00:39:30,686 a policy to integrate cash to the environment. 489 00:39:30,686 --> 00:39:37,127 And I think today I've enjoyed our discussion too much. 490 00:39:37,127 --> 00:39:40,462 I've learned, I mean, myself I learned a lot about this. 491 00:39:40,462 --> 00:39:47,554 Because at HUMLOG Institute we're doing a research project on cash and
